FIU Weekly Storylines

- Tonight's game marks the start of the 11th season of FIU Football and eighth playing at the FBS level.
- Head Coach Mario Cristobal enters his sixth season with FIU in 2012 and has the program coming off back-to-back bowl seasons in 2010-11.
- FIU has a large array of veteran talent returning for the 2012 campaign, including 18 starters on offense and defense, plus both its kicker and punter. Overall, FIU returns 53 letterwinners from 2011.
- FIU begins a season for the first time receiving votes in the *USA Today* Coaches Top 25 poll, earning three votes equating to being tied for 43rd nationally.
- For the second consecutive season, the FIU football team has been picked as the preseason favorite to win the Sun Belt Conference, as determined in a poll of the league's 10 coaches.
- FIU has an all-time high seven Panthers earning spots on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Team – the most of any league member in 2012. The preseason team was selected by the league's 10 head coaches and selected media members.
- FIU starts the 2012 campaign playing one of college football's oldest programs in Duke, whose gridiron lore can be dated back all the way to 1889. 2012 will mark the 100th year of playing football for Duke (1889-94, 1920-29, 1930-present).

FIU-Duke: The Series

- The 2012 road trip to Durham concludes the two-game series with the Duke Blue Devils.
- FIU looks to even the series with Duke after dropping a narrow four-point contest, 31-27, last year in Miami on Oct. 1.
- The 2011 game saw a bulk of back-and-forth scoring in the first quarter, which led to a 17-14 Duke advantage after the first. FIU scored its lone points of the second on a Jack Griffin 36-yard field goal to tie the game at the half.
- Griffin booted a 33-yarder with 12 seconds left in the third for a 20-17 lead heading into the fourth.
- Wayne Times was on the receiving end of a 34-yard TD in the fourth as FIU took a 27-17 lead.
- On the next drive, Duke scored in three plays, as Juwan Thompson scampered for six yards. The key play was a 54-yard pass, Sean Renfree to Donovan Varner, on first down.
- After forcing a Duke punt and taking over at its own 20, the Panthers rushed twice totaling 16 yards to the FIU 36. On third down, Wes Carroll was sacked, the ball came loose and was recovered at the FIU 9 by Duke.
- One play later, DU's Thompson punched it in for the 31-27 lead switch with 6:52 to go. FIU mounted an 11-play 60-yard drive to the Duke 12, but lost the ball on downs.

Duke Notes

FIU - DUKE ROSTER CONNECTIONS

- In its history, FIU has faced three Atlantic Coast Conference opponents: Duke (0-1), Maryland (0-3) and Miami (0-2). Additionally, FIU played future ACC member Pittsburgh (0-1) during the 2010 season.
- The Duke game also marks FIU's 75th all-time contest to be played at night (6 p.m. or later).
- While he was an assistant coach at the University of Miami, Mario Cristobal faced Duke twice, winning on both occasions. In 2005, UM won 52-7 in the Orange Bowl, and in 2006, the Hurricanes won 20-15 in Durham.
- Along with Cristobal, current FIU Special Teams Coordinator and Secondary Coach Jeff Popovich was a graduate assistant at Miami (2005-06) and outside linebackers coach Juan Navarro, Jr., was a volunteer coach at UM in 2006.
- FIU does not have a player from North Carolina on its roster, while 13 Blue Devils hail from the Sunshine State. FIU freshman Fadol Brown attended North Carolina Tech (prep school).
- FIU's Darian Mallary and Duke's Conner Vernon were teammates at Miami's Gulliver Prep.
- FIU's T.J. Lowder and Duke's Jordan Byas both attended Bay HS in Panama City.
- FIU sophomore transfer Jakhari Gore and Duke's Travis Gibson both attended Miami's Christopher Columbus High.
- Cristobal graduated from the University of Miami in 1993 and Duke defensive line coach Rick Petri came to Coral Gables to coach the Hurricanes' defensive line from 1993-95. Petri did return to Miami for the 2010 season under former Head Coach Randy Shannon, whom Cristobal also coached with.

ON THIS DATE (SEPTEMBER 1)

- FIU has played twice on September 1, splitting the two games.
- **2007:** at then-No. 17 Penn State, FIU fell to the Nittany Lions in front of the largest crowd-ever to watch the Panthers play (107,678). The game also marked the start of the Mario Cristobal era at FIU.
- **2011:** The 2011 season-opener took place on Thursday evening, a home victory over Sun Belt rival North Texas.

FIU AMONG NATIONAL LEADERS IN RETURNING VETERANS

- According to Phil Steele, FIU will return one of the largest senior classes in the nation in 2012. According to early preseason rosters, FIU, Nebraska, Kansas State and Louisiana Tech were the only programs with 30 or more seniors.

WHAT FIU HAS COMING BACK IN 2012?

- FIU has a large array of veteran talent returning for the 2012 campaign, including 20 starters and 53 letterwinners from last year's Beef 'O'Brady's Bowl squad.
- Returning per unit is:
 - **Offense:** 8 starters, 22 letterwinners
 - **Defense:** 10 starters, 27 letterwinners
 - **Special Teams:** 2 starters, 4 letterwinners

2012 ROSTER FILLED WITH STARTERS

- 40 players on the 2012 roster have started during their FIU careers. Those 40 players have combined for a total of 474 starts, an impressive average of nearly 12 starts per player. 425 of the 474 combined starts have come during the 2011 and 2010 seasons.
- **22 on defense have 253 starts**
 - Nine defensive backs have 111 starts (Leader: **Johnathan Cyprien** 33)
 - Nine defensive linemen have 83 starts (Leader: **Tourek Williams** 26)
 - Four linebackers have 59 starts (Leader: **Winston Fraser** 31)
- **16 on offense account for 168 starts**
 - Six offensive linemen have 88 starts (Leader: **Rupert Bryan** 29)
 - Six wide receivers have 55 starts (Leader: **Jacob Younger** 22)
 - Three running backs have 23 starts (Leader: **Kedrick Rhodes** 11)
- **The kicker and punter have for 53 starts**

WHAT IS LOST FROM THE 2011 SQUAD?

- **Offense:** Despite eight starters returning, the offense lost four players, including three starters:
- **T.Y. Hilton**, WR: 2012 NFL Third Round Draft Pick by Indianapolis...broke several FIU and Sun Belt career and single-season records...a former multiple All-Sun Belt selection and player of the year.
- **Wes Carroll**, QB: Two-year starter...part of an offense that led FIU to back-to-back bowl berths.
- **Curtis Bryant**, RG: 21 combined starts over his last two seasons.
- **Jonathan Faucher**, TE: 25 career starts at tight end.
- **Defense:** 2012 All-Sun Belt Honorable Mention defensive end **James Jones** was the lone starter to graduate.
- **Special Teams:** FIU lost its primary return specialist in T.Y. Hilton.

2012 ROSTER NOTES

- On the present 105-man roster:
 - 44 Freshman (31 True & 13 Redshirt)
 - 18 Sophomores (7 True & 11 Redshirt)
 - 13 Juniors (7 True & 6 Redshirt)
 - 30 Seniors (21 True & 9 Redshirt)
- 80 percent of FIU's 105-man roster (84 players) is from the state of Florida.
- 24 Florida counties are represented from the northwest panhandle, to the first coast in the northeast and all along the way through Collier in the southwest gulf region.
- 44 percent of FIU's 105-man roster (46 players) is from the Tri-County (Miami-Dade 31, Broward 8 and Palm Beach 7) area.

PANTHER GRADUATES

- Seniors **Mitch MacClugage** (Criminal Justice), **Andrew Mattox** (Sports Administration Studies) and **Jeremiah Harden** (Liberal Arts Studies) all received their bachelor's degrees over the summer and are now pursuing Master's degrees in their final collegiate seasons.

CROSSING STATE LINES IN 2012

- FIU's six-game road schedule in 2012 includes travel to just three states outside of Florida: North Carolina (Duke), Louisiana (U. Louisiana) and Alabama (Troy, USA). FIU faces intra-state rivals UCF and FAU, on the road, as well.
- The three states visiting is the lowest since FIU played outside the state of Florida two times during its inaugural 2002 season (Elon - North Carolina; WKU - Kentucky).

National Notes

FIU EARNS PRESEASON TOP 25 VOTES

- FIU football received its first points in a pre-season poll, earning three in the *USA Today* Coaches Top 25 Poll, essentially tied for 43rd, along with Missouri and Tennessee.
- The last time FIU received points in the *USA Today* Coaches Top 25 Poll was 11, last season on Sept. 18, after the team began the year 3-0, defeating North Texas, Louisville and UCF in successive weeks.
- Five of the state's FBS schools start the season receiving points including No. 7 Florida State (1,055), No. 23 Florida (25), USF (12, No. 34), UCF (5, No. 41 tie) and FIU (3, No. 43 tie).

CBSSPORTS.COM'S JERRY PALM STARTS FIU AT NO. 38

- FIU begins 2012 ranked No. 38 in *CBSSports.com* 1-124 rankings, as calculated by BCS/Bracketology expert Jerry Palm.
- Louisville (29), UCF (32), Louisiana (34) and Arkansas State (51) are FIU's highest-rated 2012 opponents and are all played on consecutive weeks, Sept. 15 through Oct. 4.

PRESEASON NATIONAL AWARD CANDIDATES IN 2012

- This preseason, a record-tying five FIU student-athletes appear on five individual national award watch lists. In 2006, FIU also had five players named to preseason watch lists.

- The five national awards watch lists in 2012 leads the Sun Belt Conference and are the third-most for FBS schools in Florida.
- WKU in the Sun Belt, and USF within the state, also has five players, respectively, on national award watch lists, but both schools are only named for four different awards lists. Both schools each have two Rotary Lombardi award candidates.
- Florida State has 19 players, and Florida 16, vying for 11 awards, respectively.

20 EARN PRESEASON RECOGNITION

- 20 FIU student-athletes have garnered some level of preseason recognition by the various college football magazines or web-sites (See Pg. 7).
- In *Athlon's*, *Blue Ribbon*, *CBSSports.com*, *Lindy's* and *Phil Steele* publications, FIU led all Sun Belt schools in players selected to their respective All-SBC First-Teams.

FIU BECOMING MORE FAMILIAR IN TV HOUSEHOLDS

- So far, eight FIU regular games have been selected for TV in 2012. Last season, FIU had a total of eight games that were televised.
- In 2011, seven regular season games made it on air, concluding with an eighth telecast, ESPN's Beef 'O'Brady's St. Petersburg Bowl.
- Since the 2010 season, including 2012, 26 FIU will be on television – that is over double the amount of games televised in **Mario Cristobal's** first three years (12).
- FIU went 10-8 in TV games during 2010-11, as compared to 1-11 from 2007-09.

BACK-TO-BACK BOWL SEASONS (2010-11)

- FIU appeared in postseason bowl games the past two seasons, 2010 (Little Caesars Pizza Bowl) and 2011 (Beef 'O'Brady's Bowl).
- Of the 90 schools that have appeared in bowl games in 2010 and 2011 combined, the Panthers are among 50 to have earned back-to-back invites.
- Since FIU joined the Sun Belt Conference in 2005, only four Sun Belt schools have had bowl appearances in consecutive years, with Troy leading the way with a streak of three invites.

SEVEN PANTHERS HONORED ON ALL-SUN BELT FIRST TEAM

- For the second consecutive season, the FIU football team has been picked as the pre-season favorite to win the Sun Belt Conference, as determined in a poll of the league's 10 coaches.
- FIU had an all-time high seven Panthers earning spots on the Preseason All-Sun Belt Team – the most of any league member in 2012. The preseason team was selected by the league's 10 head coaches and selected media members.
- Making the list were running back **Kedrick Rhodes**, offensive linemen **Rupert Bryan**, Jr., and **Caylin Hauptmann**, defensive linemen **Isame Faciane** and **Tourek Williams**, linebacker **Winston Fraser** and defensive back **Johnathan Cyprien**.

- Of mention, no other Sun Belt school had repeat picks outside of FIU's Hauptmann, Williams, Fraser and Cyprien, who made the preseason team in 2011. FIU also led the league with six preseason All-Sun Belt picks last year, in addition to Hilton's pre-season player of the year honor.

2012: SEASON 11...10 YRS IN 10 BULLETS

- 2012 marks FIU's eleventh season playing football, and the eighth FBS season. The Panthers began at the NCAA Division I-AA level (2002-04), and then played an FBS transition schedule (2005-06). At the time, FIU became the fastest school in the history of college football to reach the highest level, FBS (three seasons).
- In 2005, the Panthers also began playing a Sun Belt schedule, with full-member status in 2006. FIU will join Conference USA on July 1, 2013. C-USA was part of the recent conference realignment. C-USA in 2013 will include: East Carolina, FIU, Louisiana Tech, Marshall, North Texas, Rice, Southern Miss, Tulane, Tulsa, UAB and UTEP. Charlotte and Old Dominion join C-USA for the 2015 season.
- Head Coach Mario Cristobal, who enters his sixth season with the Panthers in 2012, is regarded as one of the country's top college football coaches and is the architect of an FIU program that has been to back-to-back bowl games (2010-11).
- FIU enters 2012 coming off one of its most successful years in program history where the school captured a record eight regular season victories, along with milestone wins on the road at eventual Co-BIG EAST Champion Louisville and at home against C-USA title contender UCF.
- FIU began its successful streak in 2010, when Cristobal led FIU to its first Sun Belt title and bowl victory over MAC champion Toledo. For his efforts, he was named the league's Coach of the Year.
- FIU plays its home games at Alfonso Field at FIU Stadium, which has been in place at the current site since 2008. Recent stadium expansion to enclose the north side of the structure was completed in the off-season, elevating capacity to 20,000.
- The site first began as FIU Community Stadium (2002-06) before complete renovation. The team played 2007 at the former Miami Orange Bowl, now the site of Marlins Park, during construction of its new stadium. The FIU vs. North Texas game on Dec. 1, 2007 was the last college football game ever to be played in the Orange Bowl.
- The Panthers start the 2012 campaign on the road, similar to past seasons, having played away from home in seven of 10 previous season openers. FIU won its 2011 season opener, 41-16, a home game vs. North Texas.
- FIU opens its home schedule in Game No. 2 (Sept. 8), against Akron. FIU defeated Akron in the first-meeting, last season on the road, 27-17, wrapping up a 3-1 non-conference record. The 3-1 non-conference record was the best in program history, and short of perfect by a narrow four-point home loss to Duke, 31-27. In that game, FIU held a 27-17 fourth quarter lead, and led 27-24 until the Blue Devils scored at the 6:52 mark.
- Only new Sun Belt member South Alabama, in Game No. 10, is a first-time opponent for FIU in 2012.

KEDRICK RHODES READY TO RE-WRITE RECORDS IN 2012

- After setting the single-season rushing mark in 2011 with 1,149 yards rushing, junior running back **Kedrick Rhodes** enters 2012 poised to re-write several FIU career rushing records. In his two previous seasons combined, Rhodes has appeared in 21 games, 11 starts, for 1,442 yards on 274 carries.
- In 2012, the Doak Walker candidate should become FIU's career leader in rushing yards, carries, 100-yard games, rushing/receiving plays and receptions by a running back.
- 1,442 yards places fourth [#1 Rashod Smith 2,195 yards].
- 274 carries places fifth [#1 Darriet Perry 435].
- Six 100-yard games places second [#1 Rashod Smith 7].
- 309 rushing/receiving plays places fifth [#1 Darriet Perry 475].
- 34 receptions by a RB places fourth [#1 A'mod Ned 57].
- 5.3 yards per carry currently places first all-time.

JOHNATHAN CYPRIEN LOOKS FOR TOP TACKLE RECORD

- Senior safety **Johnathan Cyprien** enters 2012 with 272 career tackles, just 30 shy of tying the school career record held by Scott Bryant (302; 2006-09). Cyprien, a 2012 Thorpe Award Candidate, who has had 78, 113 and 81 tackles, in his three previous seasons, has averaged 7.2 tackles per game in his 38 career appearances.
- His 113 tackles as a sophomore were the most by a sophomore at FIU, and stands as fourth-most in a single-season at the school.
- Cyprien, five forced fumbles, stands one shy of tying that school record, held by Antwan Barnes (6; 2003-06). He also ranks fourth at FIU with 17 pass break-ups.

JACK GRIFFIN KICKS WAY INTO RECORD BOOK

- Senior placekicker **Jack Griffin** has posted the top two scoring seasons, overall and by kicking, for an FIU football player with 96 and 102 points, respectively. The 198 total points places him No. 2 all-time, 35 points shy of tying inaugural kicker Adam Moss' (2002-05) school record of 233 points. However, Griffin would have accomplished the feat in three seasons versus four seasons for Moss.
- Griffin's 22 and 17 field goals made in 2011 and 2010, respectively, were also the top two marks in that category all-time. In addition, he has also nailed the top two amounts of extra points per season during that same span, 45 and 36.
- As impressive, the former Groza Award semifinalist has twice had a string of 11 consecutive field goals made, another run of eight, and has not missed an extra point during his collegiate career (81-for-81).

TOUREK WILLIAMS GOES BEHIND THE LINES ON DEFENSE

- Senior defensive end **Tourek Williams** is among the program's all-time best at the FBS level in tackles for loss and sacks. (FIU moved up to FBS in 2005, after starting at FCS in 2002.)
- The preseason Sun Belt Defensive Player of the Year enters the season tied for third with 31.5 tackles for loss and is just 2.5 behind No. 2 Keyonvis Bouie (2003-06). His TFL yardage, 140, ranks second.
- With 11.5 career sacks, he falls one short of second all-time (Daunte Foster, 12.5, 2002-04). Williams also places second with 99 career sack yards.

Head Coach Mario Cristobal - Sixth Season



Mario Cristobal will enter his sixth season as head coach of the FIU football program in 2012 and he has become widely-regarded in the coaching profession for the impressive success his tenure has brought to Florida International University.

Not only has Cristobal established a rock-solid foundation for the FIU program to strongly build upon, he was also the architect for one of the greatest turnarounds in college football and sustained periods of success in recent seasons.

The Panthers are now one of only 50 programs across the country who has participated in back-to-back bowl games in 2010 and 2011. Since Cristobal took over the program in 2006, only three other Sun Belt schools have had consecutive bowl appearances and FIU could equal the record of three straight with a postseason berth in 2012.

During this historic run, Cristobal has guided FIU to a 15-7 mark in its last 22 games entering 2012 - the best stretch in the program's history. In this span, FIU has led its opponents in nearly every statistical category.

Such success has translated to greater exposure nationally. With five games already tapped for the networks in 2012, the Panthers will have been on television 23 times since 2010. The 23 games since 2010 is over double the number that was broadcast during Cristobal's first three years combined (7).

FIU football enters 2012 coming off one of its most successful seasons all-time. In 2011, the Panthers won a program-record eight regular season games, along with milestone wins on the road at eventual Co-BIG EAST Champion Louisville and at home against Conference USA standout UCF. The team would go on to advance to its second-straight postseason game, the 2011 Beef O'Brady's St. Petersburg Bowl vs. Marshall.

In 2010, Cristobal coached FIU to its first Sun Belt Conference championship and first bowl appearance, a victory over Mid-American champion Toledo in the Little Caesars Pizza Bowl. That year, league coaches proudly recognized Cristobal as the Sun Belt Conference Coach of the Year.

Named the second head football coach in FIU history on Dec. 19, 2006, Cristobal implemented his philosophy of hard work and dedication, which quickly paid dividends both in on-field results and academic success in the classroom.

But Cristobal always realizes that success in the fall doesn't end with the final whistle in December. The head coach personally logs thousands of miles each off-season recruiting, attempting to attract top high school and junior college talent to South Florida. The 2011 and 2012 signing classes have been noted by recruiting analysts to be among the best in the Sun Belt Conference the past two seasons.

Cristobal expects more than just effort on the field. He demands effort in the classroom, as well. After just one year on the job, not only did the Panthers record their highest grade point average in the history of the program, but they also saw 31-percent of the team achieve academic honors earning grade point averages between a 3.0 and 4.0. Those academic achievements have only continued to escalate.

There might have been no one else more suited and perfect for the head coaching post at FIU than Cristobal. His roots in the Magic City make him the perfect candidate to mine the talent-rich football state that Florida is. He was born and raised in Miami and played high school football less than four miles from the FIU campus at nearby Christopher Columbus High School.

He is often recognized in the community for his heralded playing days at the University of Miami (Fla.) under the Hall of Fame head coaches Jimmy Johnson and Dennis Erickson. He would then go on to learn coaching under Miami mentors Butch Davis, Larry Coker and Greg Schiano.

Progress and success are all that Cristobal has known in his time as a player and coach. Cristobal came to FIU after successful coaching tenures at Miami (Fla.) (Coker) and Rutgers (Schiano), where he recruited and coached some of the best talent in the country.

A 1993 graduate of the University of Miami, Cristobal was a four-year letterman for the Hurricanes from 1988-92. An All-BIG EAST offensive tackle, he was a key member and leader of one of the proudest and most successful programs in the history of the sport.

Following college, Cristobal signed as a free agent with the Denver Broncos in 1994. He would go on to represent the NFL with the Amsterdam Admirals of the NFL Europe League during the 1995 and 1996 seasons.
